Nominations for the vacancy opens on Wednesday 24 April 2019.

Nominations must be lodged by 4.00pm Wednesday 1 June 2019.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates are required to lodge with the RETURNING OFFER (Shire CEO);

- A completed nomination form in the prescribed form, signed & witnessed. This form is available from the Shire of Mingenew, 21 Victoria Street, Mingenew or <https://mingenew.wa.gov.au/elections/>
- A single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of biographical information about the proposed candidate and statements of the candidate's policies and beliefs
- A nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, postal order or bank cheque)
- A recent passport size photograph (optional)

When an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or faxed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.
