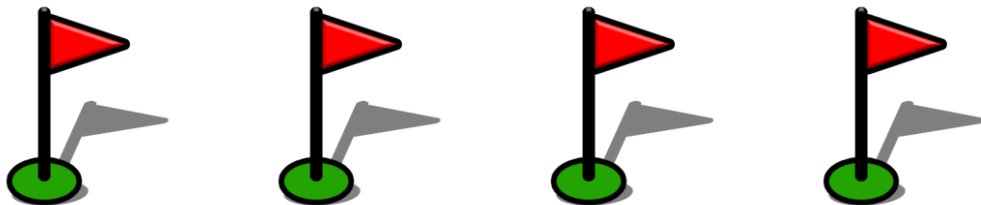

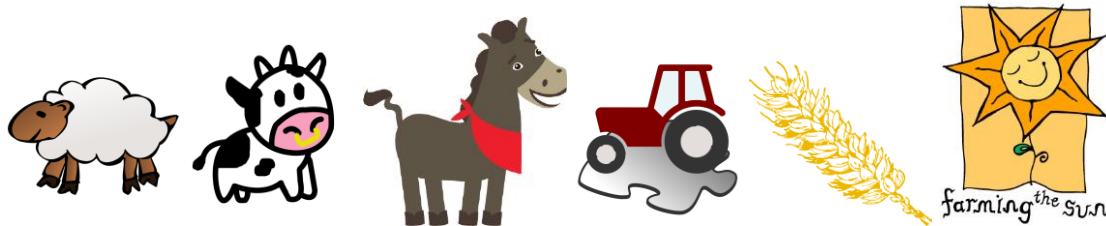

- *Please note that players entered in Stableford competition-Event 10 are not eligible for Events 1-9 or Teams events.*
- *Veteran's Competition will be played over Saturday & Sunday. Players 60 years and over.*
- *All entrants playing Stroke are eligible for the Teams Events.*

Team's Events - \$5 per person

Closed Nett	Rose Bowl Competition - Best 3 cards to count
Closed Gross	Best 4 cards to count
Open Gross	Best 4 cards to count
Open Nett	Best 4 cards to count

Composite teams will be organised for Clubs with less than 4 entrants. Outside Clubs are eligible for Open Gross & Nett.



Nominations close Friday 12th July 2019

Friday : \$20 per person (\$40 per pair) - Soup & Sandwiches - Afternoon Tea

Saturday: \$25 per person includes ~ Soup & Sandwiches ~ Nibbles

Saturday Evening Meal ~ \$35 per person

Sunday: \$25 per person includes Golf ~ Soup & Sandwiches ~ late Lunch

Breakfast \$10 per person

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with the Local Rules as draw up by the Match Committee.
2. Ties for the Winner in the 36 Hole Gross Events will be decided by a play-off at the discretion of the Match Committee. All other ties shall be decided on a count-back. Play off holes will be 1 and 18.
3. Handicapping - Players will retain the same handicap for the 36 Hole Event, except for Event 8, where if handicap has altered the player shall use the new handicap for this event only.
4. The Match committee & Executive Committee has full powers to alter or make any variations in the conditions of the competition should it be deemed necessary.
5. Entry Fees - Fees are forfeited & non-transferable once the draw has been finalised.
6. The audible or unauthorised use of mobile phones are not permitted on the course.
7. Measuring Devices - Devices measuring **distance only** will be permitted during this championship.
8. Motorised Carts - The Golf WA motorized golf policy will apply.
9. Trophies - Winners of Events 1 & 2 are not eligible to win Events 5 or 7.
10. ALL players are only eligible to win one Nett Trophy.
11. Players entered in Stableford competition-Event 10 are not eligible for Events 1-9 or Teams events.
12. Players 60 years and over are eligible for Veterans, event 9.
13. ALL players must provide their Golf-Link number on the Entry Form
14. Practice Fairway and Green will be No 18.
15. Pace of Play - (Rule 6-7) will be enforced.
16. Disputes Committee decisions will be final.
